


User instruction for www.biomedinfo.net

1. First register yourself after clicking on **Registration** and fill all the cells.





However, please note that ***you will not be able to log in at this stage. You will be able to log in only after administrator approves your registration***, which would normally take 1-2 working days.






If you try to log in at this stage, the following screen will appear.




- After administrator approves your registration, you will generally receive another email informing you about this. Now you can log in to your account using the user name "email ID" and the password.
- It is very important now to login now as you need to join the sessions electronically that you wish to attend. ***Please note that you would be able to join a session only before its scheduled date. Please also note that unless you join a session, you will not be able to download the PDF of the slides.***

- Click on the **"Join now"** below the session (indicated by red arrow) as you like. **You can join only before the scheduled date of the session.**



- After you click on the join now option, you would be able to download pre-session study materials by clicking on **"Click here to download study material"** as shown below with a red arrow.




- After attending a session in which you joined electronically by clicking on **"Join Now"**, you will be able to download post-session study material that will include PDF of the slides presented by the speakers. However, you will not be able to do it immediately after the

session is over as the **administrator needs to approve your participation** that would normally take 1-2 days. Please wait till then. You can download the PDF of the slides by clicking on "**View completed e-sessions / download slides / give feedback**" as shown below by red arrow.





9. Once you click on "**Download study materials slides**" as shown below




